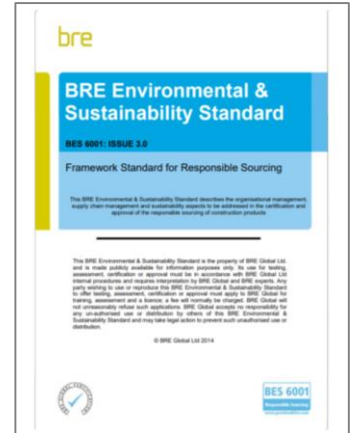

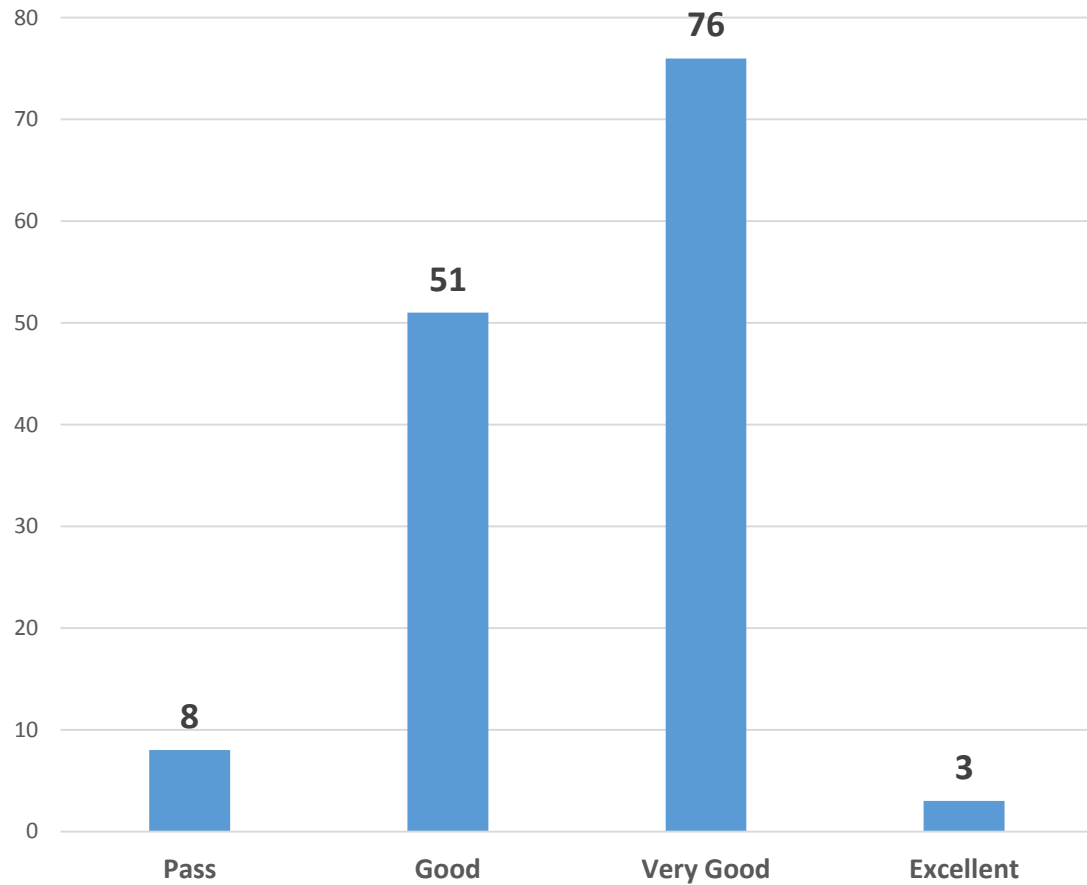

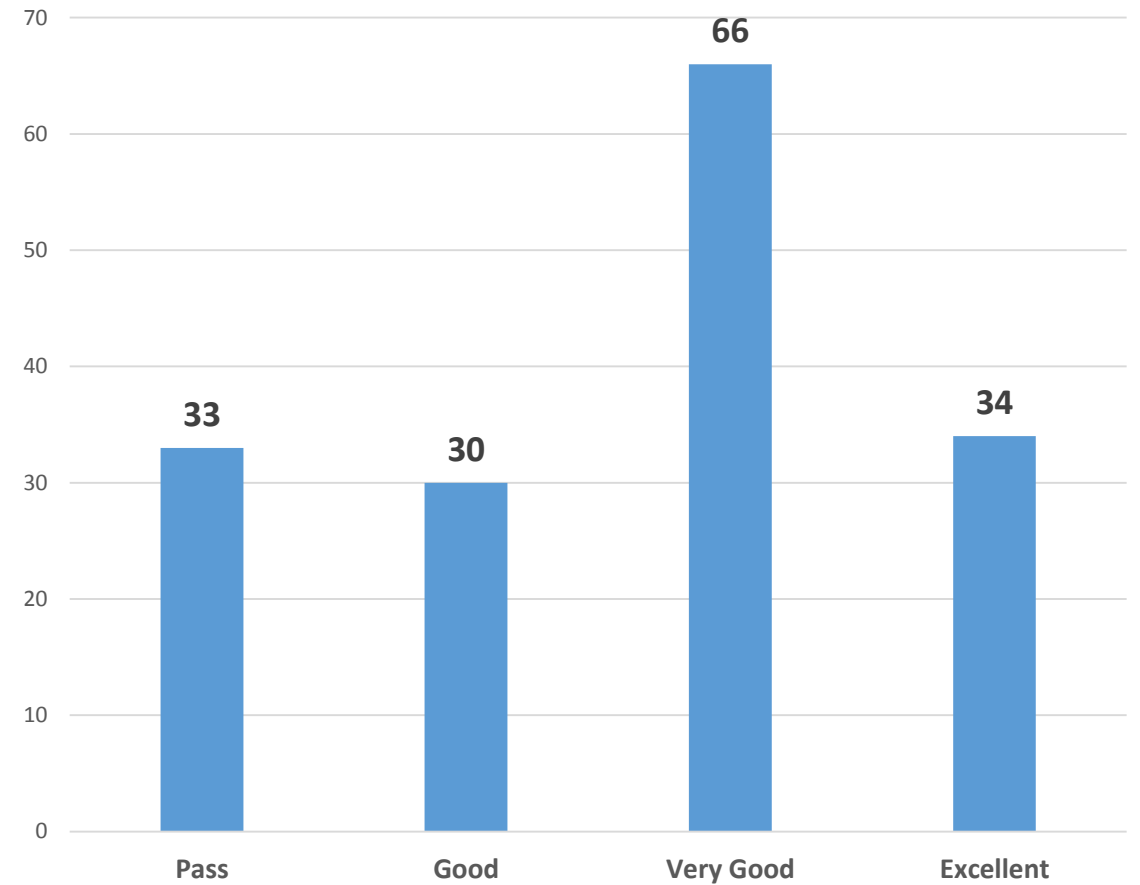

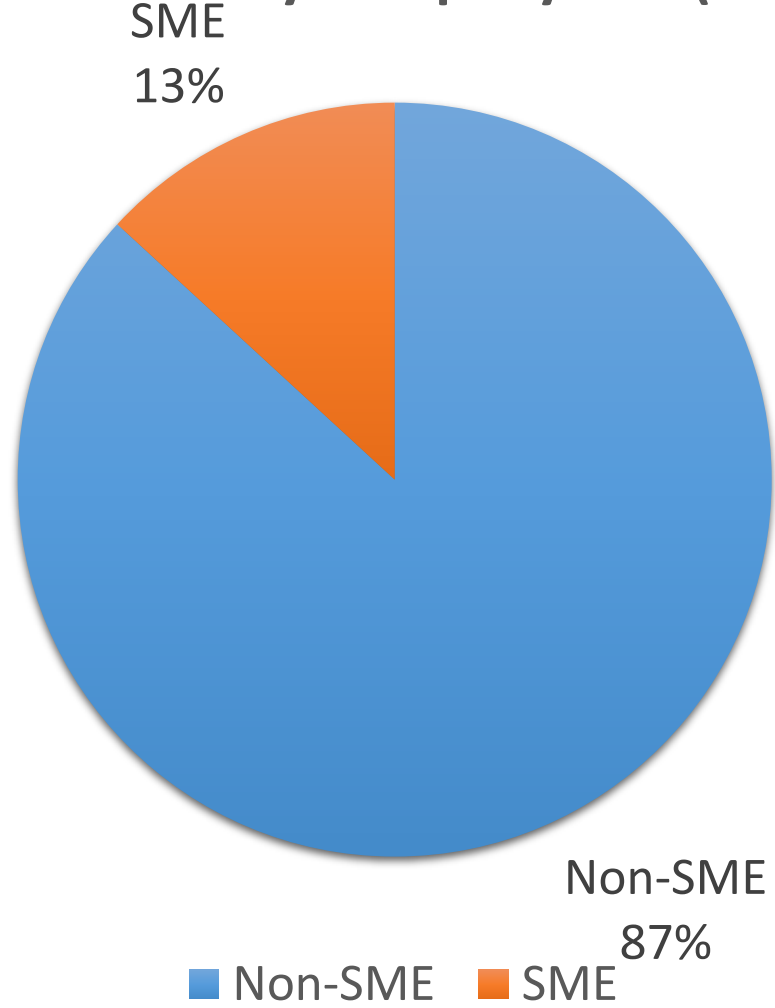
BES6001 levels of attainment, 2013



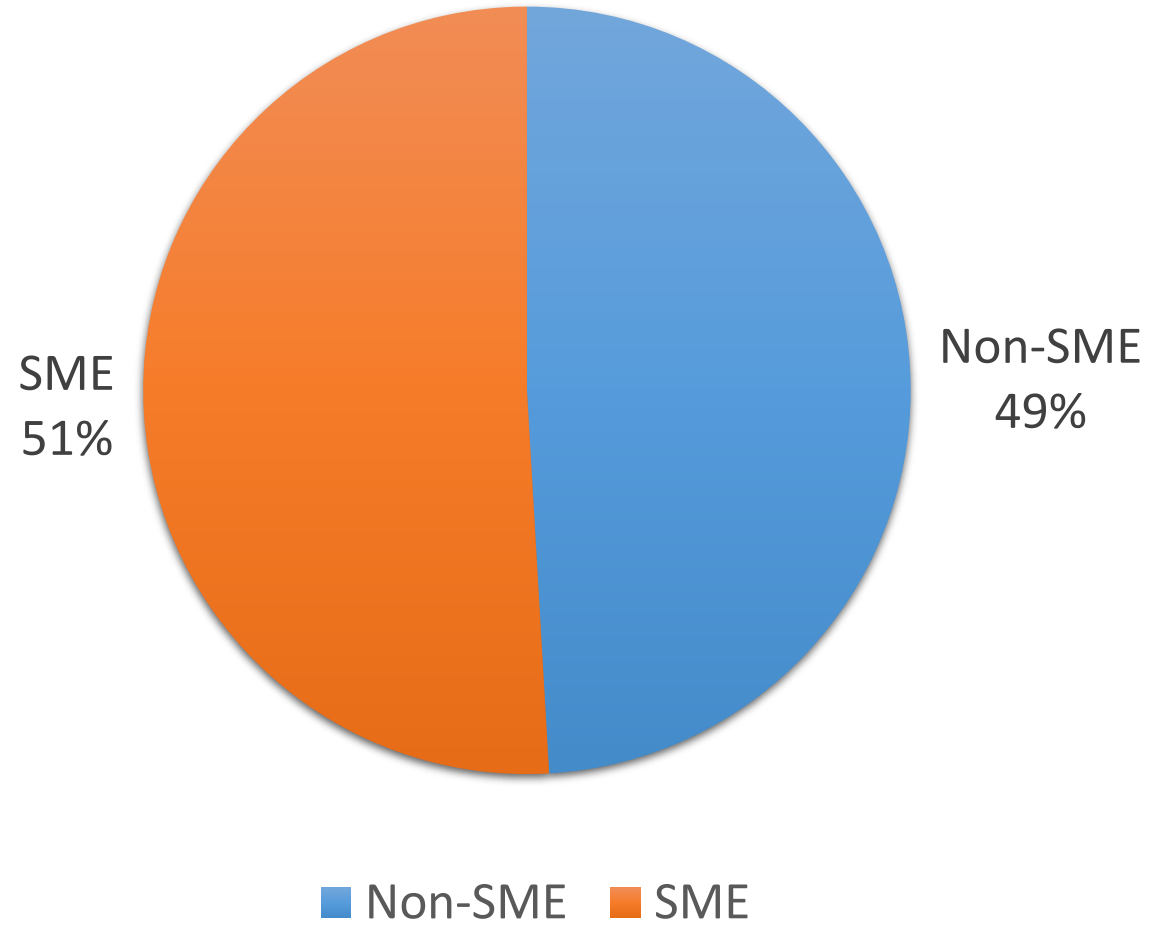
BES6001: Levels of attainment, 2018



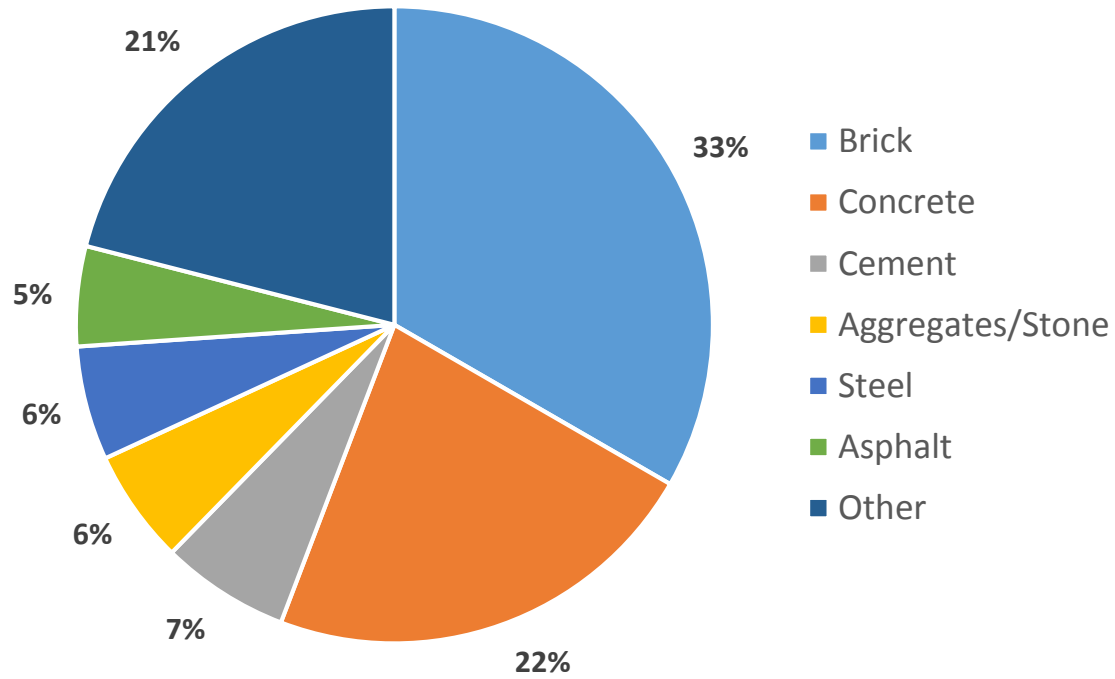
Certificates by company size (2013)



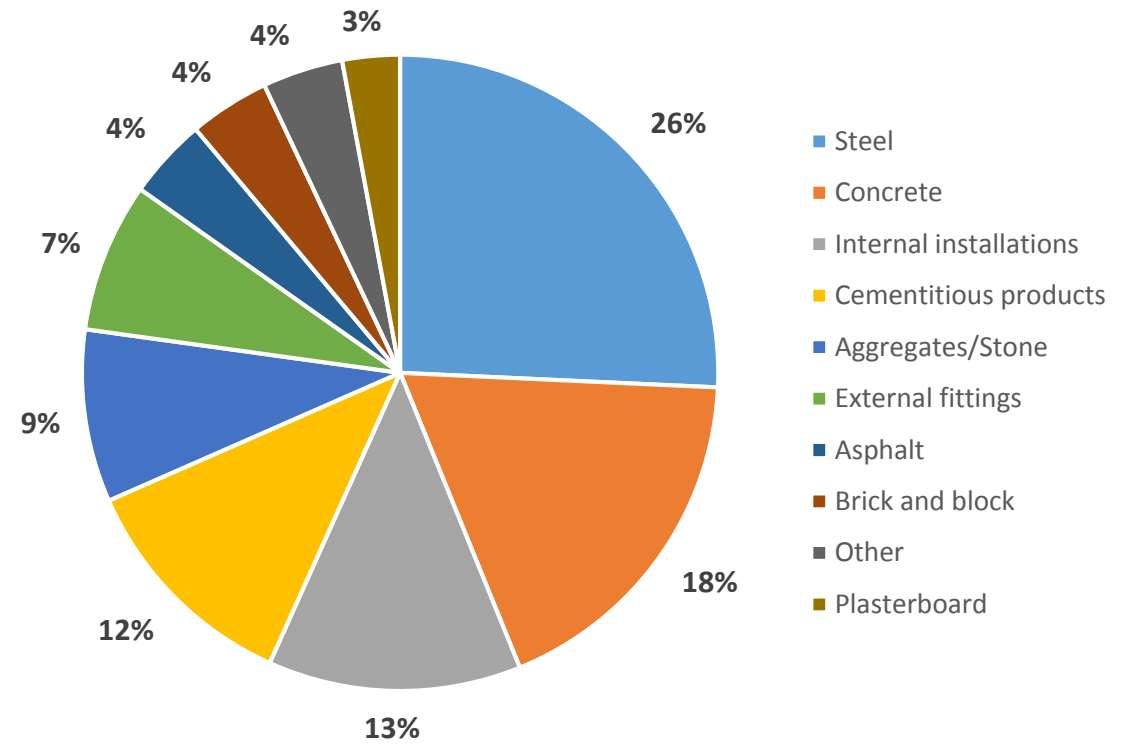
Certificates by company size (2018)
