Letter to Constructing Excellence members re Performance Measurement Forum

Dear Members,

I am writing to you in my capacity as Chair of the Constructing Excellence Performance Measurement Forum as you are a member organisation of Constructing Excellence. We really need your help, and if you are able to support us we can offer you some real insight which you can use to drive performance in your own organisation or the clients that you serve.

You will be aware that our Mission at Constructing Excellence is about "*Positively disrupting the industry delivery processes to transform performance*". Central to the realisation of this Mission is the need to measure performance - focussing on data, benchmarking and practical tools for change.

To this end we have re-launched our Performance Measurement Forum. This group helps measure, benchmark, understand and improve project performance on established KPIs against the rest of the construction industry. It is strongly aligned with the development of KPIs with the Construction Innovation Hub and the Construction Leadership Council. In 2020 the group will continue to focus on best practice in collecting and analysing project data, enabling Constructing Excellence members to share data in a trusted, safe-space and extract meaningful insights.

The attached/enclosed slide deck give a little more information on the progress made over the past year and data and potential insights from our successful proof of concept.

We would really like your organisation to join and expand the expertise of the group and the data set to increase our coverage of project types and locations.

What we need from you is senior buy-in to the concept, access to your project data (or your client's data with their permission), and the time and expertise of relevant staff for data collection. This is not too onerous as we only collect data on a six monthly cycle.

In return you will gain valuable actionable insights, be able to influence the agenda of the group and to share best practice with a like-minded peer group in a safe space.
