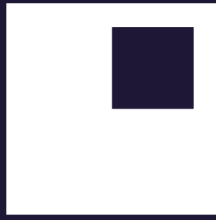

On 11th June 2024, the Climate Action group came together to hear from Jamie Hillier, Partner at Akerlof, about their Carbon Blind Spots report.

The group heard how the report enforces the need for greater consistency and transparency within the industry to build more effective benchmarking, but also to build pressure amongst peers in order to persuade others to begin making more positive changes.
